Reduction of N₂O by 90%

Gummersbach, 13.08.2025:

KEMAPCO® Arab Fertilizers & Chemicals Industries Ltd appointed Steinmüller Engineering GmbH to engineer, deliver and supervise the installation and commissioning of an advanced secondary nitrous oxide abatement system at the nitric acid plant in Aqaba, Jordan.

The project follows a Grant Agreement between KEMAPCO® and the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit GmbH (GIZ, German Society for International Cooperation) and is funded by the German government. It is being implemented as part of the Nitric Acid Climate Action Group's (NACAG) initiative, which was launched by the German government at the 21st Conference of the Parties in 2015. NACAG advocates the implementation of efficient nitrous oxide (N₂O) abatement technology in nitric acid production facilities worldwide, providing eligible partner countries with technical, political and financial support.

The plant's nitrous oxide emissions will be reduced by 90%. The work is expected to be completed in 2027.



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
